## JUNE 15, 2025 ALL SAINTS SUNDAY



We are obliged, not only to venerate the saints & to seek their assistance, but also to imitate their life and holiness. All Christians are called to holiness by virtue of the sacrament of the Holy Baptism. Every person, regardless of status and condition of life, can become a Saint and is duty-bound to strive after holiness of life. Jesus Christ addressed all people without exception: "Therefore, be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect". Saint Paul also reminds us: "This is the will of God - your sanctification."

Thus, what is holiness? Holiness is living according to the commandments of God and the Church; it is the daily fulfilment of God's will, constant fidelity to the duties of one's state, or briefly, it is the Gospel translated into action.

Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky says: "In my opinion the source of our failures and of all the plagues that afflict our church and national life, is our failure to apply ourselves seriously to living our Christianity and the teachings of the Gospel, and for this reason, we do not convey to others the aura of holiness..."

*Troparion, T.8:* You came down from on high, O Merciful One,\* and accepted three days of burial\* to free us from our sufferings.\* O Lord, our life and our resurrection,\* glory be to You!

*Troparion, T.4:* Clothed as in purple and fine linen\* with the blood of Your martyrs throughout the world,\* Your Church cries out to You through them, O Christ God:\* send down Your loving-kindness on Your people;\* grant peace to Your community,\* and to our souls great mercy.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kontakion, T.8: O Lord, Master of nature,\* the world offers You the godly martyrs as the first-fruits of nature.\* By their supplications, through the Mother of God,\* preserve Your Church and Your people in profound peace,\* O most merciful One.

*Prokeimenon, T.8:* Pray and give thanks to the Lord our God. *verse:* In Judea God is known; His name is great in Israel.

A Reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews 11:33-12:2: Brothers and Sisters, all the saints through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions, quenched raging fire, escaped the edge of the sword, won strength out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. Women received their dead by resurrection. Others were tortured, refusing to accept release, to obtain a better resurrection. Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned to death, they were sawn in two, they were killed by the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, persecuted, tormented — of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, and in caves and holes in the ground. Yet all these, though they were commended for their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had provided something better so that they would not, apart from us, be made perfect.

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.



# ♦ ANNUAL PILGRIMAGE TO THE GRAVESITE OF ROSE PRINCE. Dates: July 11, 12 & 13

Many pilgrims say they experience God's healing presence and power in their lives during the pilgrimage as they pray for real-life issues, hurts and joys. The example of Rose Prince is like a compass, gently guiding the way by her life spent simply with concern for others and a deep love for God.

Several years ago Nick Loza, a miner from the Fraser Lake area, experienced a miraculous healing when

Father Goulet anointed and prayed over him through the intercession of Rose Prince. After two operations for a broken disc in his back the neurologist had given up hope of further recovery. Though he did not know Rose Prince when she was alive, Nick and his wife attended the pilgrimage in recognition of the healing he received.

At the 2004 pilgrimage, Bishop Gerald Wiesner noted that Rose Prince "was a rather ordinary person. She lived her human life fully and her faith life deeply in a rather extraordinary way. That is probably the greatest appeal she has." Like Mary and Joseph in Nazareth, Rose's life was mostly one of unseen service to others.

The story of Rose Prince is one of a young woman who spent her life as a cradle Catholic, growing in a state of extraordinary virtue while inspiring others to do the same.  $\sim$  B.C. Catholic

The cause for Rose Prince's canonization has not yet been opened. However, the holiness of her life, her incorruptible body, and the healings that have been attested to her intercession since make her seem a likely candidate for sainthood. She could be BC's first saint and Canada's second First Nations saint.
