NOVEMBER 16, 2025 BRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



It's easy and tempting to assume that we follow Jesus because we are righteous or that we are made righteous by following Jesus. We separate ourselves from "them" who are not righteous. But that's not what Jesus does. In today's Gospel reading He doesn't do that to the dinner guests or to the religious authorities.

Jesus deepens and responds to the question the authorities ask. "I have come," he says, "not to call the righteous but sinners." "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick." Do you hear what he is doing? He's equating sinners with patients who are hurting and in need of healing.

Have you ever thought of sin as a medical condition rather than a legal issue? What if sin is less about the actions we usually focus on and more about the wounds or hurts that cause us to act out? What if we could see our own sins and the sins of others in that way? Maybe we would desire, learn, and practice mercy instead of sacrificing others and ourselves. And who among us doesn't need some mercy now and then?

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God— not the result of works, so that no one may boast. 

EPARCHIAL NEWS

In accordance with the Resolutions of the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church, and in agreement with the "Proposals regarding the Implementation of the Pastoral Plan 2030 in the Field of Christian Families,", Most Rev. Bishop Michael Kwiatkowski has called upon clergy, religious and lay-faithful of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of New Westminster to take to heart and generously act upon the following:

- The year, beginning on the feast of **St. Philip (14 Nov. 2025) through**

Thanksgiving Day (12 Oct. 2026), is designated as **A Year for Families**. This designation aims to promote the importance & vital role of Christian families in society and in the life of the Church, especially during times of war, social instability, and other contemporary challenges facing families.

- The motto for this Year is: "*Patient in hope, strong in love*" (Rom.12:12).
- Every parish and mission community is called to observe a period of persistent prayer for Christian families especially **during the Nativity Fast (St. Philip Fast), November 15 December 24.**
- During this period a Special Petition is added to the daily Divine Liturgy
- Adapted Prayer of Metropolitan Andrey Sheptytsky to be recited after each Divine Liturgy during this period
- A Week for the Family to be observe from Mother's Day to the following Sunday 10-16 May 2026.
- Friday 15 May 2026 to be acknowledged as the International Day of the Family. If a Saturday or Sunday will prove more effective, the parish celebrations may be held on a date near to the $15^{\rm th}$.
- All Christian families at the parishes are encouraged to organize themselves into Christian Family parish organizations under the supervision & spiritual accompaniment of their pastors. These parishlevel organizations shall be united into a Christian Family Movement within the Eparchy.

LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast of the entrance of the Theotokos into the Jerusalem Temple is commemorated on the **21st of November**. The text of the service tells that Mary was brought as a child to the temple by her parents to be raised there among the virgins consecrated to the service of the Lord until the time of their betrothal in marriage. According to Church tradition, Mary was solemnly received by the temple community which was headed by the priest Zacharias, the father of John the Baptist. She was led to the holy place to be "nourished" there by the angels to become the living sanctuary and temple of the Divine child who was to be born in her.

The main theme of this feast is the fact that she enters the Temple to become herself the living temple of God, thus inaugurating the New Testament in which are fulfilled the prophecies of old that "the dwelling of God is with man" and that the human person is the sole proper dwelling place of the Divine Presence. When the child Mary enters the temple, the time of the temple comes to an end and the "preview of the good will of God" is shown forth. On this feast we celebrate — in the person of Christ's mother — that we too are the house and tabernacle of the Lord.

We are the temple of the living God, as God said, "I will live in them and move among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people"
